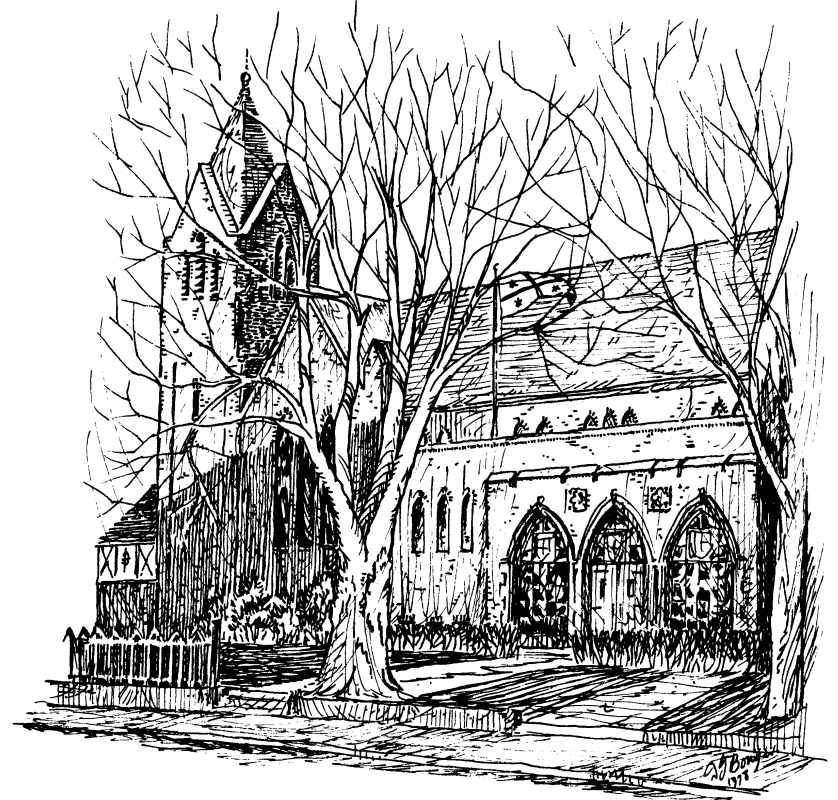

Parking is available at the Fred Gies Legion, corner Belmont & Gage Sts. Enter the parking lot via Belmont St. or Gage St. Please park in the designated spaces only. Cross Gage St. and walk a short distance towards Victoria Street along the Iron Horse Trail. The Habitat build site is on your left. Parking is also available at Victoria Bowling Lanes, 280 Victoria St. South, across from City Cafe. Park in the spaces closest to Victoria and go around the building to the Iron Horse Trail. SUMMER SAFETY TIP: When going camping leave a detailed plan of your trip with a dependable person. Learn basic first aid and take a first-aid kit with you. Obey all posted signs and warnings. Scout the campsite before building a camp. Put your food and cooking utensils out of the reach of animals - never in the tent. When building a fire, make sure the area is cleared of debris and is away from trees, shrubs, tents and vehicles. Never leave the campfire unattended. Don't stand under a tree during a thunderstorm; move to the shoreline if you are in a boat. Don't bring barbecues inside the tent for warmth; use in ventilated areas only. Never approach or feed wild animals. Happy camping!

The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew.

Jesus said, "A disciple is not above the teacher, or a slave above the master; it is enough for the disciple to be like the teacher, and the slave like the master. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebul, how much more will they malign those of his household! So have no fear of them; for nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered, and nothing secret that will not become known. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the light; and what you hear whispered, proclaim from the housetops. Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell. Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. And even the hairs of your head are all counted. So do not be afraid; you are of more value than many sparrows. Everyone therefore who acknowledges me before others, I also will acknowledge before my Father in heaven; but whoever denies me before others, I also will deny before my Father in heaven. Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth; I have not come to bring peace, but a sword. For I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law; and one's foes will be members of one's own household. Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me. Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it."
