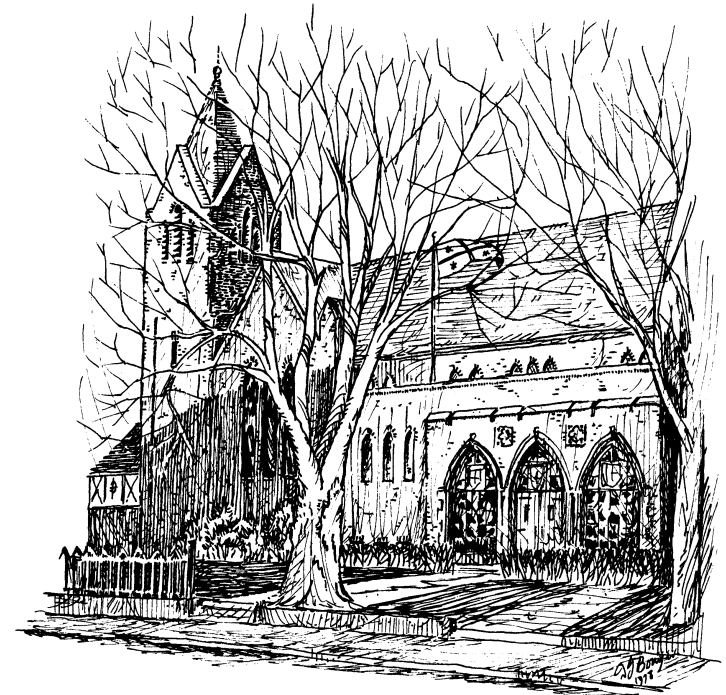

The May financial statements are now complete and are summarized below.

Our YTD shortfall to the end of May is over \$18000 more than we had budgeted. We anticipate making up about \$10000 of this when some extraordinary income is received during the next two months. Year to date envelope givings are about \$5000 less than we budgeted based on the approvals given at the Annual Vestry meeting. In order to operate our Church in a responsible manner, we must each strive to keep our offerings up to date. As always, questions comments and suggestions will be welcomed.
